Boardman Community Baseball's goal is for everyone involved with the program, to have a positive experience. The following is a list of expectations we have of our players:

Be responsible for reporting to practices and games on time.
To be determined by Manager.
Call if going to be late or miss.

Be responsible with communicating with your coach.
Let parents or coach know if there are any problems.

Be respectful towards:
Your teammates.
Your opponents.
Your coaches.
Umpires.

Display good sportsmanship.
Never throw a bat or helmet.
Don't make fun of peers.
Congratulate others for doing well.

Don't be a "bully".
Physical or mental harassment will not be tolerated.
Any problems should be reported to the Player Agent.

1st offense – "strike one" – written warning or possible game(s) suspension
2nd offense – "strike two" – game(s) suspension
3rd offense – "strike three" – suspended for the remainder of season
(subject to discretion of the BCB Board of Directors)

AND --

No possession or use of any of the following at anytime and anywhere -
Weapons (knife, guns, etc.)
Tobacco Products & Alcohol
Illegal drugs

1st offense – "strike one only" (for the above point) – suspended for the remainder of season (subject to discretion of the BCB Board of Directors)

After violation is reported to Player agent, a meeting with the manager, player and parents will be set up to discuss the punishment. The committee will decide on the consequences of each action on an infraction by infraction basis.
