Winners will be awarded scholarships at the 14<sup>th</sup> annual Chuck Schafer Memorial Scholarship Tournament at Boardman Community Baseball's Fields of Dreams June 30 - July 2, 2017. For the 2016-2017 academic year, two \$2,500 scholarships will be available to selected applicants that meet the following criteria:

### CRITERIA:

1. Senior Status
2. Accumulative GPA of 2.75
3. Participated in Boardman Community Baseball for: 5 years in the baseball or softball program
4. Complete Chuck Schafer Memorial Scholarship Application
5. **ESSAY: Not to exceed 500 words. Discuss how Little League and participating in Boardman Community Baseball have structured and affected your daily life. Essays will be evaluated on originality, presentation of ideas, good use of grammar and spelling. Applications submitted without essay will be disqualified.**
6. Submit the completed APPLICATION form with high school TRANSCRIPT and ESSAY.
