

2017 Chuck Schafer Scholarship Tournament

9 year old, 9-10, 10-11 and 11-12 Year Old Teams

- 2 umpires for each game
- Each team will play a minimum of 3 games
- Each team **MUST** have a pitcher affidavit before the first game. The affidavit must be exchanged prior to game and signed by the opposing team's coach upon completion of each game (Please exchange prior to game)
- Pitching limited to 10 innings for the tournament, no more than 6 innings per day.
- All players must play defensively six outs and bat at least once per game, If 13 or more players available for play, all players must bat once.
- One courtesy runner is allowed per inning; one time only per player, per game and runner must not be currently in the game
- Little League Tournament substitution rules
- 2 adults may coach the bases
- No on deck batters allowed
- Games are 90 minutes long with no new inning beginning after 90 Minutes. There will be no time limits during championship games. After first inning, 3 warm up pitches (continuing pitcher) and no infield or outfield warm up.
- Use of an illegal bat will cause ejection of Manager from game and the following game. List of approved bats on BCB/Little League website**
- Sunday seeding Tie Breaker and Rain Policy: 1) Head to Head 2) Average Runs Allowed 3) Coin Flip

PONY Teams 13 and 14 year olds

- 2 umpires for each game
- Each team will play a minimum of 3 games
- Each team **MUST** have a pitcher affidavit before the first game. The affidavit must be exchanged prior to game and signed by the opposing team's coach upon completion of each game (Please exchange prior to game)
- Pitching limited to 12 innings for the tournament, no more than 7 innings per day
- PONY rules will be followed
- 1 E. P can be used in line up
- Courtesy runner for pitcher or catcher allowed, use last out in lineup.
- Games are 120 minutes long with no new inning beginning after 120 minutes. There will be no time limits during championship games. After first inning, 3 warm up pitches and no infield or outfield warm up.
- Use of an illegal bat will cause ejection of Manager from game and the following game. Bats barrel no larger than 2 5/8 and if -3 BBCOR certified, See Pony Rule book via Pony link on BCB website.**
- Sunday seeding Tie Breaker and Rain Policy: 1) Head to Head 2) Average Runs Allowed 3) Coin Flip

All other rules will follow Little League Tournament or Pony rulebook.

Winning teams must report score back to administration building, Please confirm exact score with losing team upon game completion. Coaches are responsible that proper score is recorded.
